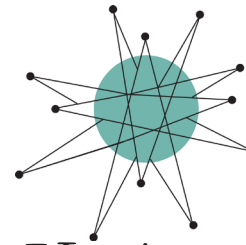
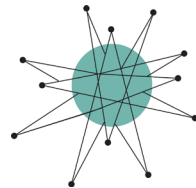

What's all the hoopla about?

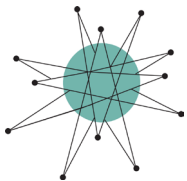

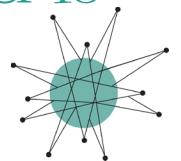
