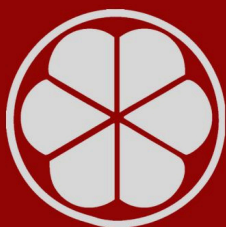

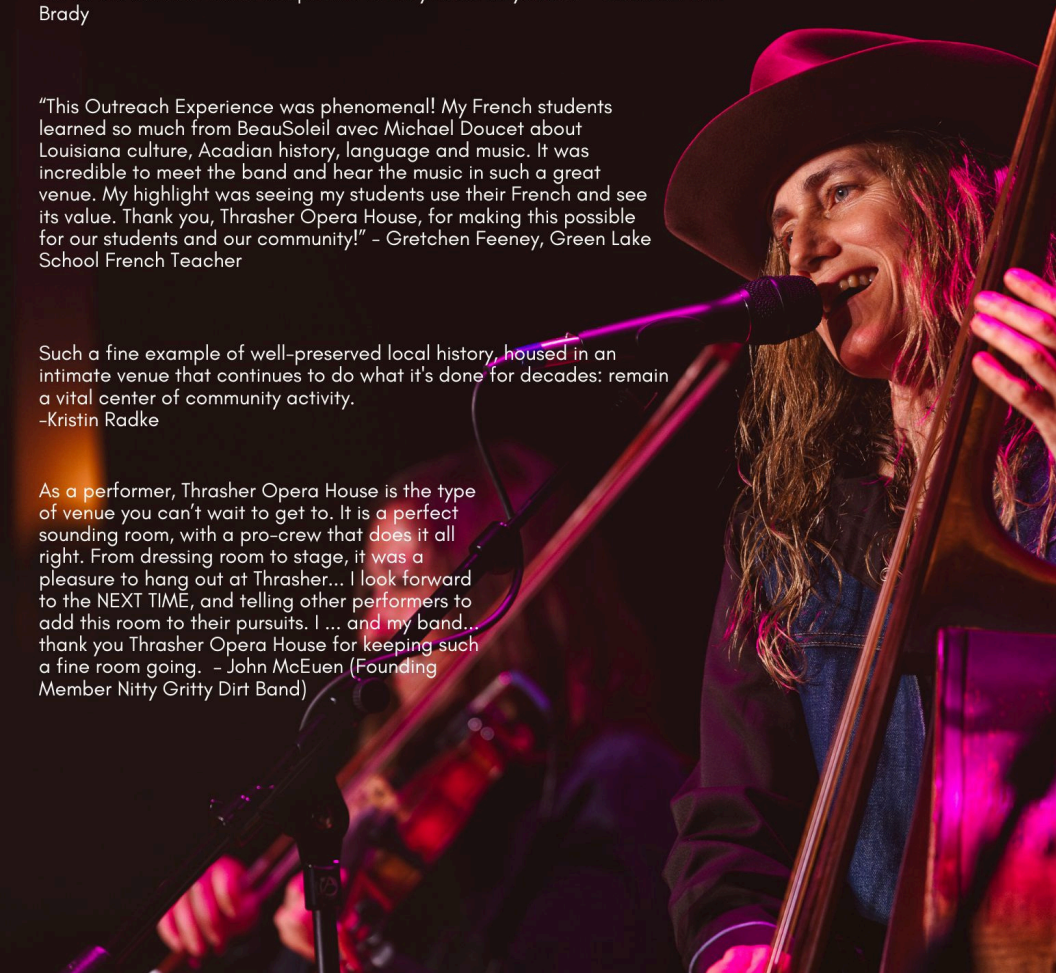

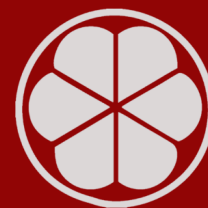

- Ticket Sales 40%
- Donor Support 29%

THRASHER OPERA HOUSE ENDOWMENT & INVESTMENTS

- Oshkosh Area Community Foundation: \$72,704 (TOH provides an annual Scholarship for two local students pursuing the arts from this fund)
- Endowment Fund: \$1,109,697
- Thrasher Internal Line of Credit: \$50,000
- Thrasher Reserve Account: \$50,000
- CD: \$105,000
